

Course Objectives

8. Describe and classify the phenomenon of cop killings.
9. Describe the effects of TASERs, pepper spray and police dogs on the mentally ill offender
10. Apply appropriate techniques when assessing for judicial competence in defendants invoking the UCC defense
11. Discuss and understand the phenomenon of fetal abduction.
